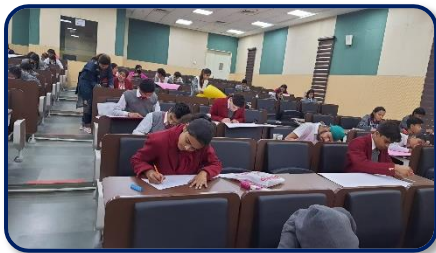
### ✚ Republic Day Celebration
