Report on "UDAAN" Outreach Tele Health Consultation Model"

"UDAAN" An Outreach TeleHealth Consultation Model" was launched on 16 October 2021 in joint collaboration of Social Outreach cell AIIMS Rishikesh and IIT Roorkee under the flagship program of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan.

"Outreach telehealth consultation model" through digital platform A unique approach to dealing with primary health care in Remote Uttarakhand

The aim of this model is not only to impart therapeutic care but rather to address the quarries, concerns, and worries of the rural and remote population through qualified medical experts. We have witnessed the role of medical experts during the acute crisis of the COVID-19 pandemic. The entire system was undergoing the panic stage, to deal with this stage, this technology telehealth consultation might help to alleviate their issues and challenges.

Under the leadership of Nodal officer AIIMS Rishikesh Dr. Santosh Kumar, this program was successfully able to cater the services to people in need in the outreach area of Hilly Uttarakhand. Senior consultant and specialist from AIIMS Rishikesh consulting outreach patients through this software, addressing their quarries and concerns.

Feedback from the patients treated through teleconsultation through social outreach staff was also found satisfactory.

Objectives

- **1.** To provide telehealth consultation to the hard-to-reach areas, rural populations where the health facilities are not available, even the poor network access.
- 2. To ease out the assessement to the health care during the covid 19 pandemic.
- 3. To strengthen primary health care through the equipped telemedicine consultation.

ACTIVITY 1:

Name of Activity: SHG formation Initiative (Initiative in village Chandpur)

Need for the Activity: To help financially deprived families by formation of a SHG.

Description: With the aim of empowering women in the rural society, this initiative involved enrolling needy and financial deprived women in the village to come together and form and SHG. By the formation of SHG, the women can collectively run a business and help their families. The team contacted the women one by one and provided them with complete information of the procedure and method of enrolment for the SHG. They were also told that after the formation of the SHG, they will be trained after which the women can run their own business and aim to become financially stable. All documents required were submitted in the office and now the training of the women will commence in short span of time.






















ACTIVITY 2:

Name of Activity: Yoga Awareness and Practice Initiative (Initiative in village Meerpur)

Need for the Activity: The aim is to help the students to get access of the desired books they need. Upon surveying, it was analyzed that they had to research a lot to find the needed resources.

Description: The team upon surveying, analyzed that the students have to struggle a lot to get the desired books and they sometimes lag behind due to lack of resources. To solve this issue, the team members searched the desired books and provide to students in pdf format. The team created a drive link to easily find and categorize the books. The drive link consisted different types of books like reading books, course books in Hindi as well as in English. It also had some previous year question paper of JEE, NEET etc. After sharing the link in the WhatsApp Group with the instructions, the team member called the students to tell them about the drive.











ACTIVITY 3:

Name of Activity: Vermicomposting Initiative (Initiative in village Chharba)

Need for the Activity: To promote and inculcate organic farming ways among the villagers and to provide them a better alternative to fertilizers.

Description: Intending to promote ways of organic farming among farmers and making them independent for manure used, UBA team Chharba contacted the villagers and explained them how organic farming can increase the overall produce gradually over the years. Later, 2 farmers agreed on building a vermicompost pit in their field. The team helped in setting up 10 ft long, 3 ft wide and 2 ft deep vermicompost bed in the field and point-sourced the ingredients required for preparation of vermicompost. The team will provide the villagers with the worms required on the next village visit.

ACTIVITY 1:

Name of Activity: RTE Survey (in village Beladi)

Need for the Activity: To make sure that every child gets the benefit of Right to Education Act (RTE).

Description: Right to Education Act (RTE) is an Act of the Parliament of India enacted on 4 August 2009, which describes the modalities of the importance of free and compulsory education for children between the age of 6 to 14 years in India under Article 21A of the Indian Constitution. UBA IITR team had visited the Beladi village and identified the children who fulfilled the above criteria's and asked their parents to arrange some important documents like Aadhar Card of Child and parents, Birth Certificate of Child, Parents' Annual Income Certificate and hand it over to the team as soon as possible, so that the certificates will get uploaded in proper time to avail the scheme of RTE. And for this,1y members of UBA had called the parents for cross checking that whether the documents are ready or not. If the documents were ready, they had given the names of intermediate person who would collect the documents and hand it over to the team in campus, whereas if the documents were not ready, they had informed the parents about the desired places from where they could get those documents ready and finally hand it to UBA team









ACTIVITY 2:

Name of Activity: FFC "friends from campus" Initiative (in village Chharba)

Need for the Activity:

Description: FFC "friends from campus" is long term initiative in which team UBA students will teach and do doubt solving of many subjects of weak and needy students of schools. Presently team is focusing on one subject (maths) and less students (class 8 only). And for that team conducted two online doubt solving classes of English (February 19, 2022) and Maths (February 13, 2022) with the students. So, team have gathered some important insights and up next team will be focusing on students' weak topics and further extending it to other subjects and more students.

ACTIVITY 3:

Name of Activity: Computer Installation Initiative (in village Chandpur-Horawala)

Need for the Activity: To install computers in Government Inter College for better education of the students and teacher training programs.

Description: On discussion with Mr. Negi, principal of Government Inter College (GIC), Horawala, the team found out that the number of computers installed in the school wasn't sufficient for the students. Along with this, GIC, Horawala is the centre of the teacher training program and computers were not sufficient for the training. Also, the number of students was going to increase in the school from 250 to 500, so the team decided to increase the number of computers in the school. Mr. Kinshu collaborated with department authorities and consult them regarding spare computers of IIT Roorkee. All the spare computers were collected in the UBA IIT Roorkee office. Later, the team checked all the computer systems and found that 7 computer systems were in good condition. Then, the team properly placed those computer systems safely in a vehicle and transported them to GIC, Horawala. After reaching school, we installed the computers in the school and cross-checked their working after the installation. The school authorities were very happy with the initiative and thanked UBA for giving those computers. Mr. Negi, Principal of GIC, Horawala, also thanked us for the initiative and praised UBA IIT Roorkee and told us that he will help UBA team as much as possible for the development of the school. The number of computers in the school has increased from 8 to 15. More students can now learn at the same time enabling more frequent computer classes for a batch.





















ACTIVITY 4:

Name of Activity: (initiative in Puranpur and Meerpur)

Need for the Activity: To get an extensive idea about the problems faced by the villagers in order to find respective solutions.

Description: Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee had organized a training seminar for SHGs (Self Help Groups) on February 23, 2020. It was an informative session for SHGs of Puranpur and Meerpur collectively. It was done with the help of RSETI officials who gave the information about different kinds of trainings to SHGs. The session saw participation of 55+ SHGs and village women from Meerpur and Puranpur. Most of them were from SHGs. The Seminar started with the introduction of UBA and RSETI. Mr. Rajan Bhardwaj and Ms. Maryada introduced team UBA and RSETI's functioning to the participants. The session was concluded by giving vote of thanks to RSETI officials and motivation to participants to take trainings as much as they can to improve their livelihood and efficiency.

List of Activities:

UBA activities at IIT Roorkee are student-driven. Around 130 students are actively involved in carrying out different initiatives in the five adopted villages. The following report contains the data of activities conducted in the adopted villages in March 2022.

ACTIVITY 1:

Name of Activity: Holi Stall Initiative (Initiative in village Chandpur).

Need of the Activity: Upon surveying it was found that the SHGs were not able to find a suitable market for their local handmade colours. The initiative was also carried out to empower rural women and make them self-reliant.

Description: Team Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, IIT Roorkee, in association with the Self-Help Groups (SHGs) of villages Chandpur and Horawala organised 'Holi *ke Rang*- an Organic Colour Stall' for the campus residents. The main objective of the stalls was to solve the problem of market for the local homemade products. The stalls hosted appealing organic-homemade *gulal* of various colours at pocket-friendly prices. The overall response from the campus was overwhelming. The sheer number of visitors and their keen interest towards the idea was inspiring for the SHGs. These initiatives play an extraordinary role in developing the confidence of the SHG members and fostering a sense of self-belief, along with providing them with a platform to showcase their talent.











ACTIVITY 2:

Name of Activity: DDU-GKY Campaign initiative (Initiative in village Chharba).

Need of the Activity: To effectively tackle the problem of unemployment of youth in the village and spread awareness about the *Grameen Kaushalya Yojana*.

Description: Grameen Kaushalya Yojana or DDU-GKY is a Government of India youth employment scheme. In which eligible rural people are trained with some skills to get jobs. Team UBA, in association with Dev Rishi Educational Society organised an awareness campaign to aware and enroll the youth. The camp was done in Santoshi Mata Mandir(later GIC chharbha) with Mrs. Alka Joshi(SHG Head) and Mr. Aamir Khan (Pradhan) as chief guests. The awareness campaign showed an impressive turnout and a large number of students of GIC Chharba were present at the venue. The chief guests addressed the audience and emphasized upon the importance of acquiring a good skill set to find a stable job.











ACTIVITY 3:

Name of the activity: Vermicomposting Initiative (Initiative in village Beladi)

Need for the activity: To come with organic alternatives to the harmful chemical fertilizers that cause soil infertility, and to spread awareness about the benefits of using vermicomposting.

Description: Vermicomposting is the process by which worms are used to convert organic materials (usually wastes) into a humus-like material known as vermicompost. Agriculture based only on chemical fertilizers and other chemical inputs is not desirable because constant use of such inputs causes soil infertility and affects productivity.

To solve this problem in the village Beladi, Team Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, IIT Roorkee decided to implement vermicomposting. The team initiated the cause by bringing some worms and testing them in the laboratory of IIT Roorkee. The results were phenomenal, worms replicated and formed good compost. After analyzing the results, the team brought the worms from Organic Pura Firm, a self-business in Unnav, and with the help of cattle dung from farmers successfully implemented the idea of vermicompost in the farms of Beladi.











ACTIVITY 4:

Name of the activity: Dental Health Camp Initiative (Initiative in village Meerpur)

Need for the activity: To examine, treat, and educate people about dental health and to get insights into the endemic diseases prevalent in various communities.

Description: The Team in association with Seema Dental College and Hospital organized the dental camp on March 26, 2022. The camp offered information on dental problems, cavities, caries, their treatment, prevention and precaution to all the villagers and students who attended it. To spread awareness of the Health Camp, the Team was divided into three groups, each with two members. Each group distributed pamphlets to villages and talked to the villagers about the camp as they campaigned door to door. The dental camp was successfully able to spread awareness about dental hygiene and dental care amongst the citizens of the village. It also motivated people to focus on their health and prioritize it.

ACTIVITY 1: Entrepreneurship development and self-help group - Sarkhet - 22/02/22

Name of Activity: Mushroom Cultivation Training / workshop

Need of the Activity: Villager are dependent on Traditional Farming for their Livelihood. Training will help them to earn additional Rs. 10-20000 per month after establishment of model unit. This area is also frequented by a huge number of tourist and so marketing of mushrooms would be easy.

Description in 200 words (along with the Pictures): A two-day workshop on the topic of employment prospects from mushroom production was organized under the "Unnat Bharat Abhiyan" of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, in Gram Sabha Sarkhet.

Inaugurating the workshop, Principal, Prof. Satpal Singh Sahni said that various self-employment-oriented schemes are being run by the Central and State Governments. He said that training of mushroom production can help villagers to start their own enterprises.

Dr. Anoop Badoni, Director of Plantica Foundation, explained in detail to the villagers as to how they can generate good income by producing mushrooms in less resources along with their traditional agriculture. He told the villagers in detail the method of producing button mushroom, and dhiganri mushroom. Scientist, Dr. Adarsh Dangwal explained in detail the method of prevention of diseases during mushroom cultivation.









Program coordinator, Dr. Madhu Thapliyal told that Gram Sabha can also commercialize it by self-help group by setting up a unit of rural mushroom production in Sarkhet. She told that its monitoring is done by the College's Unnat Bharat Abhiyan committee and student groups.

The chief guest of the program, Mrs. Neelam Kotwal, Gram Pradhan of Sarkhet, expressed her gratitude on behalf of Sarkhet Gram Sabha for this employment-oriented workshop organized for the villagers. She said that she will provide all the help needed to make this program a success.

During the program, members of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Committee, Dr. Shruti Chaukiyal, Dr. Rekha Chamoli and Dr. Pooja Kukreti also established a dialogue with the villagers and updated them about this program. Student members present were Sanjana, Shivashin, Varsha, Varsha Solanki, Shwati, Rohit, Ankit, Ashish, Vikas, Sanjay, Pooja, and Diksha. Some of the villagers who participated were Soni Devi, Meena Ranwar, Sunita, Rakhi, Rajni, Pooja, Vijendra. Village Sarkhet is 4 Km far from Maldevta/Raipur. Several villagers and Gram Pradan were among the participants. (Total number of participants – 50)

Name of Activity: Prospects of commercial trout fisheries development -Training / workshop

Need of the Activity: Maldevta area has a plethora of water resources and there are canal system that crosses these villages. These water resources can be very useful for development of commercial trout and other commercial fishers' development

Description in 200 words (along with the Pictures): A workshop was organized under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan of Government Postgraduate College Maldevta Raipur. 

- 5: Add glue on all sides of the cardboard base.
- 6: Fold the corners in triangles and seal the paper edges shut.
- 7. Using a ball point pen, pierce two holes at the open end of the bag.
- 8. Cut two pieces of ribbon. Insert the ribbons through the holes and knot both ends several times.


Purpose and Outcome






