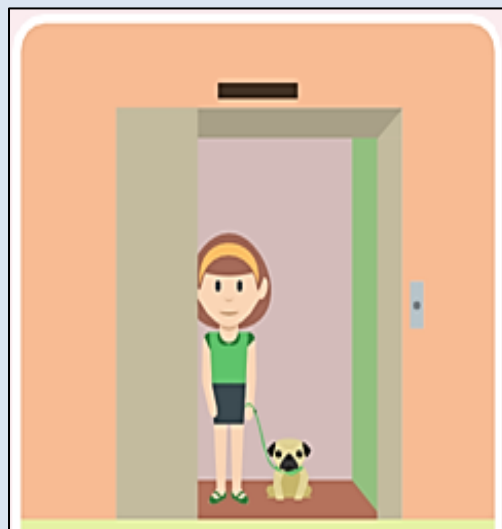

SAFE USE OF LIFTS/ELEVATORS



Supervising adults should always accompany young children and ensure they do not place their hands on lift doors



Do ensure that your leashed pet stays inside the lift as the doors close



Look out for persons rushing into the lift and press the Open Door buttons to hold the door open

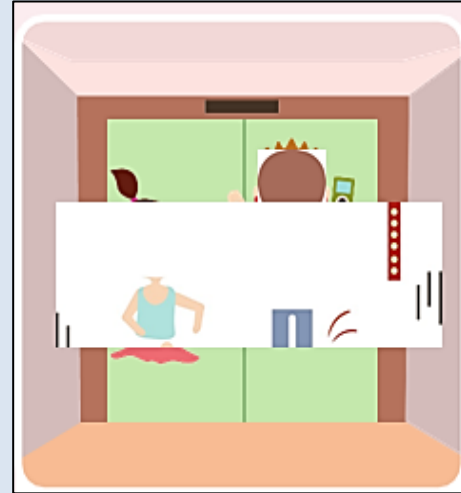


Do not use any part of the body (eg hand, legs) to stop the door for closing. Press the "Door Open" button instead

SAFE USE OF LIFTS/ELEVATORS



Do not try to open the Doors forcefully when lift stalls, Press the emergency alarm or call to emergency numbers



Do not jump or dance in the lift. This may cause lift to stall



DO not stand near the lift doors. Small & thin objects is like long shirt, leases, backup strap can caught

We use lifts everyday. Observe these Dos and Don'ts when using lifts, to keep you and your family safe
